- -Teams of four members were formed, computers assigned, passwords provided. back



Please follow the instructions on the e-syllabus under the link named "Team Web Master".

Depending on the version of Windows installed in the machine you are using, after typing <a href="ftp://www.students.umb.edu">ftp://www.students.umb.edu</a> into a browser window you may get a blank window, in that case click on "Start", then "Run" to get the window below, you need to type <a href="ftp://www.students.umb.edu">ftp://www.students.umb.edu</a> into the "Open" box.



If it still does not work, then click on "Page" on the upper right side of the Browser Window, then select "Open FTP...". When the following error message shows up, click OK.




When you see a blank window as shown below, right click on the mouse and select "Login as"



When you see the window below, enter the username and password



Now you are logged into the server, if you see a blank window, you need to upload a team homepage created using Word and named "index.html". If the homepage you created contains a picture there is a folder named "index\_files" you will need to upload here as well.



You will also need to create on the server a folder named "files" where you will upload files for the projects 0 or 1 or 2 or 3 or 4. The project files need to be named "project0.html" or "project1.html", etc. If they contain pictures you will need to upload the "project0\_files", or "project1\_files" folder to the "files" folder in the server as well. back
